AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FROMBERG MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 4-5-21 ON RENTAL PROPERTY TO PROVIDE THAT THE PERSON REQUESTING WATER SERVICE IS RESPONSIBLE FOR WATER CHARGES AGAINST PROPERTY AND THAT A DEPOSIT MAY BE CHARGED.

A

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FROMBERG, MONTANA, THAT SECTION 4-5-21 BE AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Section 4-5-21 Rental Property. The party requesting water service shall be responsible for water charges assessed against the property. If the request comes from the party other than the owner of the property, then the town shall charge a deposit of thirty Dollars (\$ 30.00) which deposit shall be:

1. Returned to the party who made application if no charges are delinquent. The amount shall be returned after the expiration of thirty (30) days from the termination of use for that party, or
2. Shall be applied towards any delinquent charges incurred by the party who made application with any remainder being returned under the above terms.

In any instance, the town shall not waive its right to an action of law for the collection of delinquent charges, and may also recover reasonable collection costs and attorneys fees.

\$75.00 per year for liquor.





The Fine shall be applied against the head of household for any household keeping or maintaining a dog running at large in violation of the Ordinances of the Town of Fromberg.



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FROMBERG MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE FOR TITLE 6 Chapter 8 PUBLIC PARKS.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FROMBERG that Fromberg Municipal Code shall contain an Ordinance reading as follows:

6-8-1 PUBLIC PARK. All parks within the Town of Fromberg shall close at 10:00 o'clock P.M. on each night and be closed until 7:00 o'clock A.M. the following morning unless a permit for use otherwise has been obtained by application to the Town Council.

6-8-02: It shall be unlawful for any person without a permit from the Town Council to be within a City Park in the Town of Fromberg between the hours of closure.

6-8-03: PERMIT APPLICATION. An application for a permit to make use of City Parks during hours of closure shall be made to the Town Council in writing and presented at a regular meeting. Said application shall be accompanied with a request fee in the amount of \$ 25.00.

The Town Council shall not authorize the use of the Parks during any of the closure hours by permit unless the use anticipated will not disturb the public peace or safety of the residents of the Town of Fromberg.

6-8-04: Violation of this section shall be punishable in accordance with the general sections of the Fromberg Municipal Code.

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING BONDS OR OTHER VALID SECURITY TO GUARANTEE RECONSTRUCTION OF ROADWAYS

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Fromberg as follows:

8-8-01.

1. Title.

This ordinance shall be referred to as the Road Rebuilding Security Ordinance.

2. Purpose.

The purpose of this ordinance shall be to guarantee reconstruction of roadways, including pavement, or other surface after said roadways have been disrupted by digging or excavation by private concerns.

3. Security.

A Any person, partnership, association, or corporation, other than the State of Montana or its subdivisions including counties and towns who are digging for the direct benefit for the Town of Fromberg, shall be responsible for re-establishing grade, and surfacing conditions, at all excavation done within dedicated city streets, alleys and roadways.

B In the event that the surface established shall fail, slip, or change within 12 months after resurfacing has been completed, said individual organization, partnership or corporation shall be responsible to again establish the surface and roadway.

C All parties excavating the roadways within the Town of Fromberg shall place with the Town of Fromberg security in the form of a bond, or other valuable security, to guarantee the re-establishment of said roadway, which security shall be held to guarantee performance in accordance with the requirements of this ordinance, not to exceed a period of twelve (12) months after completion.

D The Town Council may upon recommendation of its street commissioner or upon its own action, release the bond at an earlier date in the event that it is satisfied with the reconstruction.

E In the event that reconstruction and resurfacing has not been satisfactorily completed, or in the event that rebuilding or resurfacing fails as a result of slippage, or washout, within the time of set forth in this statute, and in the event said repairs are not again made satisfactory to the town, the town shall be entitled to make the necessary repairs after notice at the expense of the party responsible for the original excavation.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO MOUNTAIN MICROWAVE SYSTEMS, INC., THEIR SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, A FRANCHISE TO CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE A CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEM IN THE TOWN OF FROMBERG PROVIDING FOR THE MAINTENANCE THEREOF, LIMITS OF LIABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR THE TERM OF SAID FRANCHISE.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Fromberg:

1. Mountain Microwave Systems, Inc., its successors and assigns, is hereby granted a non-exclusive franchise to maintain and operate within the Town of Fromberg, a cable television system, and with said franchise the right to occupy any of the streets, alleys or public places of the Town of Fromberg for the following purposes: To place, construct, bury, and maintain upon and through the streets and alleys and rights-of-way of said Town, all poles, guys, supports and all other wires, cables and fixtures proper and necessary for supplying to the television and related service.
2. Cable television system shall mean a system composed of, without limitation, antenna, cables, wires, lines, towers, wave guides, or any other conductors, converters, equipment or facilities, designed, constructed or wired for the purpose of producing, receiving, amplifying, and distributing by coaxial cable, either audio or visual radio, television, electronic or electrical signals to and from persons, subscribers, and locations in the license area, and, in addition, the Mountain Microwave Systems, Inc. shall be permitted to provide communications service, including, but not by way of limitation, pay TV, burglar alarm service, data or other electronic transmission services, facsimile reproduction services, meter reading services and home shopping services.
3. The poles, lines and cables of said cable television system shall be placed and maintained so as not to interfere with travel on said streets, alleys, avenues and public grounds and places. All streets and alleys shall be promptly repaired to their original condition if disturbed by any installation and/or maintenance by Mountain Microwave Systems, Inc.. This grant is made and is to be enjoyed subject to such reasonable regulations made by ordinance as the Town Council may deem proper, at any time to adopt.
4. Said cable television company will indemnify and hold harmless the Town of Fromberg from all claims and demands for any loss or damage whatsoever which may arise from acts of said company and to have and maintain in effect sufficient insurance to cover such claims. Said cable company shall maintain on file with the

City Clerk a certificate of insurance showing that it has in effect such insurance coverage.

5. The Town, by and through the Town Council, reserves the right to order at any time the change or removal of any poles or wires when the public good or the convenience of travel requires it without incurring any liability to the owners of said system for damage occasioned thereby.
6. This franchise shall be in effect for twenty-five (25) years from and after the date of its passage, subject to revocation by unanimous vote of the Town Council, for just cause. Any transfer of this franchise shall be subject to the approval of the Town Council, which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.
7. This ordinance is being passed to meet an emergency in that there is a high demand for cable television to be provided to the citizens of this community, and shall take effect upon its passage and approval.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE FROMBERG MUNICIPAL CODE TO CREATE CHAPTER SEVEN (7) OF TITLE SIX (6) THEREOF ENTITLED DANCES, AND TO CHANGE PREVIOUS SECTIONS.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Fromberg as follows:

Section 01

PUBLIC DANCES.

It shall be unlawful to hold any dance within the Town of Fromberg open to the public at which music will be provided by live musicians, unless the individual or group sponsoring such dance shall first have obtained permission for the purpose of said dance in the form of a permit issued by the Town of Fromberg.

Section 02

TIME OF DANCE.

No dance open to the public shall be allowed to continue after the hour of 2:00 A.M. All people must be off the premises by said time, or this ordinance will be deemed violated.

Section 03

POLICE PROTECTION.

Party having the dance shall send to the Town Hall, before any permit is approved, an indication of the name of the party who will provide police protection for said dance. No permit will be issued if the party providing police protection is not approved by the town. It is understood that the Town Marshal shall be responsible for enforcing the open container ordinances, and all other ordinances of the Town of Fromberg at the time that the dance is being conducted.

Section 04

PERMISSION FOR A DANCE.

Under the provision of this ordinance shall indicate the name of the group sponsoring the dance, or the name of the individual, the date of the dance, the hours of the dance, the names of the musicians which may be in the form of the name of group of musicians, the name of the party providing police protection and shall be submitted no later than a week before the date of the dance.

Section 05

DENIAL.

Permission under the provisions of this ordinance may be denied for any of the following reasons:

- A. The group sponsoring the dance applied for has sponsored a dance in the past herein violation of this ordinance.
- B. Any member of the band which will provide the live music has been arrested for disturbance during a previous live music engagement in the town.
- C. Upon affirmative action of the Town Council of which the person or group asking permission must be given reasonable notice, the right to receipt of the sponsoring group or individual has been revoked as a result of drinking by minors at the last sponsored dance or as a result of disturbance being caused at the premises which could not be handled and stopped by the police officer on duty.

Section 06

PENALTY.

Any party who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor subject to the general penalty provisions of the Fromberg Municipal Code.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE FROMBERG MUNICIPAL CODE
TITLE 6, CHAPTER 5, SECTION 01, TO PROVIDE FOR UPDATED
CURFEW AGES AND CURFEW HOURS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
FROMBERG AS FOLLOWS: FROM AND AFTER THE DATE OF
ENACTMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE, TITLE 6, CHAPTER 5,
SECTION 01 OF THE FROMBERG MUNICIPAL SHALL READ
AS FOLLOWS:

6-5-01 AGE RESTRICTIONS. It shall be unlawful for any child under the age hereinafter set forth, to be upon any public thoroughfare or other public place of the town, unless such child is accompanied by his or her parent, guardian, or other person having legal care and custody of the child, or is in the performance of a temporary errand directed by such parent, guardian, or legal custodian:

- A. Children under the age of Fifteen (15):
 - Weekdays, Sunday through Friday - 9:30 P.M. to 6:00 A.M.
 - Weekends, Friday through Sunday - 10:30 P.M. to 6.00 A.M.
- B. Children in the age group of 15 through 17:
 - Weekdays, Sunday through Friday - 10:00 P.M. to 6:00 A.M.
 - Weekends, Friday through Sunday - 12:01 A.M. to 6:00 A.M.

6-5-02 DUTY OF PARENT OR GUARDIAN. No parent, guardian, of any child coming within the provision of this chapter shall allow or permit such child to go or be in or upon the public thoroughfares or other public places in the town after hours prescribed in 6-5-01, unless reasonable necessity can be shown therefore.

6-5-03 WRITTEN NOTICE TO BE GIVEN. The town marshal upon finding a child under the prescribed ages set forth above in 6-5-01, in or upon

the public streets, thoroughfares or other public places of the town, in violation of any of the provisions of this chapter after the hours prescribed, shall cause such child to be taken to his or her home and shall deliver to such parent, guardian, or custodian of the child, a written notice of the violation of this ordinance together with a notice that unless the terms of this chapter are complied with, a penalty will be invoked against the parent, guardian, or legal guardian.

6-5-04 PENALTY. The parent, guardian, or custodian of any minor who shall violate any of the provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).





AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-4-12 AND SECTION 9-3-05 OF THE FROMBERG MUNICIPAL CODE TO RAISE THE DRINKING AGE OF MINORS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FROMBERG AS FOLLOWS:

Section 6-4-12 and Section 9-3-05 of the Fromberg Municipal Code shall be re-enacted in its entirety except that wherever the age nineteen (19) now appears a change will be made so that it shall read twenty one (21) years.

Anyone with a birthday of April 1st, 1968 or before is excepted from the twenty one year old drinking and purchase age provisions. Anyone born April 2nd, 1968 or after must comply with the limitations on drinking and purchasing alcoholic beverages until they reach the age of twenty one years.


The purpose of this amendment is to update the city ordinances on the drinking age of minors.
